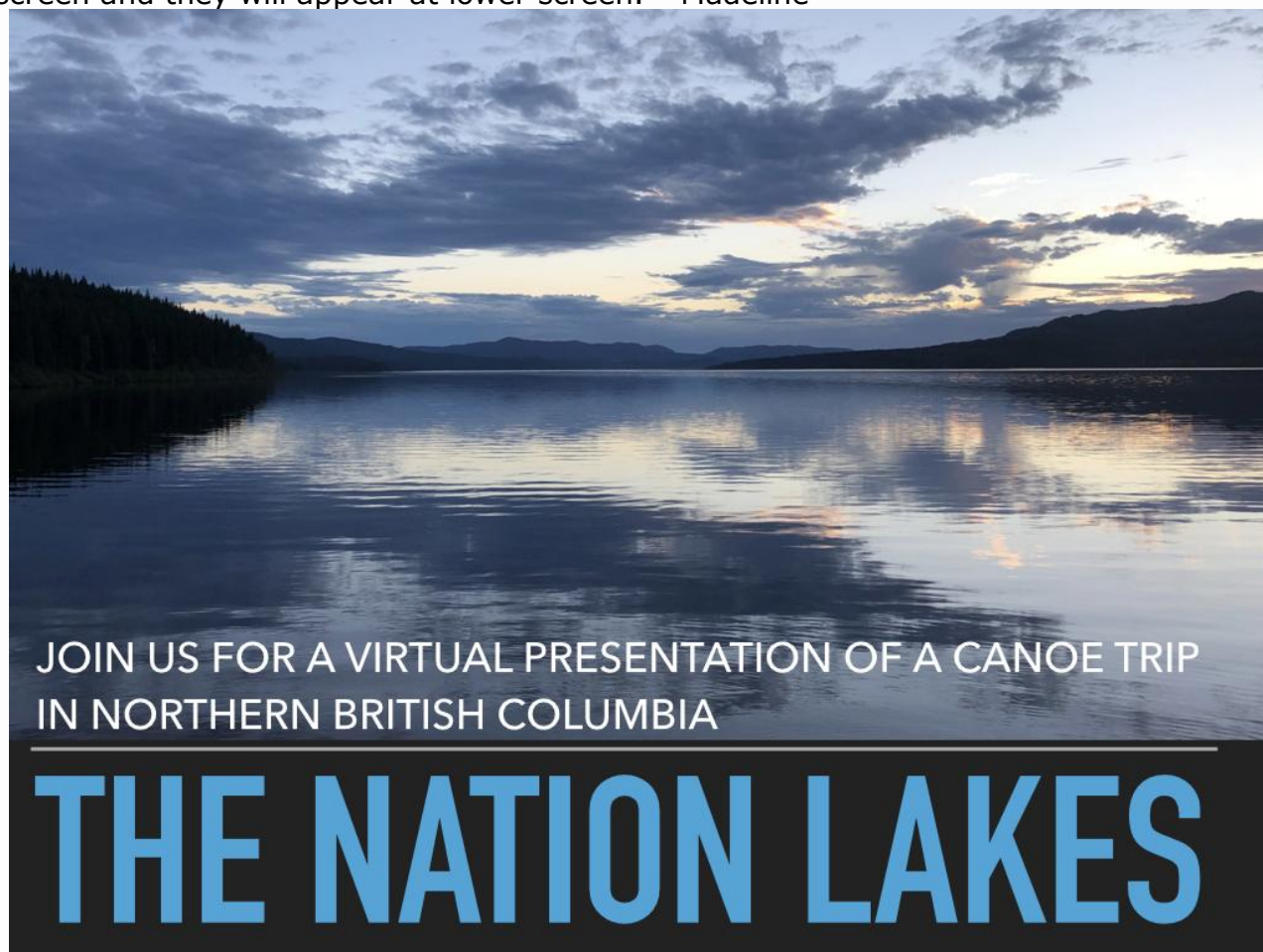
October Beaver Canoe Club Meeting (Online)

Those who have visited the Canadian Canoe Museum in Peterborough, Ont. know it as a funky old warehouse, out of which the staff has transformed the proverbial sow's ear into silk purse, with elevated lofts, dark recesses among suspended canoes in the rafters, and a cramped gift-shop. Stowed away, however, in an adjacent barn of a building, languishes the bulk of the collection to which few of the public has access, (unless you're gathered from our a smooth talker as trips director's experience). Soon though, a spanking new building will emerge along the locks of nearby Trent waterway, accompanied by the tune of 65 million loonies sourced from the feds, foundations, and canoe aficionados far and wide. The new digs may lose some of that old-cabin musty charm, but the priceless collection will then be cared for by museum-standard environmental controls and archival documentation – a better fitting legacy for this ingenious Indigenous innovation.
